VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS AND DEPENDENTS COVERED BY THE Local 282 Welfare Trust Fund Important Information Regarding Your Health Benefits

This document is a Summary of Material Modifications ("SMM") intended to notify you of an important change made to the plan of benefits of the Local 282 Welfare Trust Fund (the "Plan"). You should take the time to read this SMM carefully and keep it with the copy of the summary plan description ("SPD") that was previously provided to you. Re: Coverage of Children Where Both Parents Participate in the Plan

Dear Plan Participant,

This is an important notice regarding Dependent coverage under the Plan. This notice is intended to clarify how the Plan pays benefits when both of a child's parents are Plan Participants.

Section (c) of the definition of "Dependents" in the Plan's "Definitions" section, on page 10 of the SPD, is revised to read as follows:

c) Multiple Coverage under the Fund. In the event that both parents are Participants, a child will be considered a Dependent of one of the parents, but not both. However, if both parents are also covered as Spouses under the Plan and are each eligible to receive the same benefits from the Plan, both may file for benefits on behalf of the same covered child, as described in Section 1 (e) under "Which Plan Pays First" in the "Coordination of Benefits" section, on page 44 of the SPD. This means that both parents may receive reimbursement on a single claim for their covered child, up to the actual expense of that claim or double payment of the regular schedule allowance, whichever is lower.

As always, we will continue to look for ways to ensure that the Plan delivers high-quality benefits while remaining financially sound.
