Re: **COVID-19 Testing**

Dear Plan Participant,

The Trustees of the Local 282 Welfare Trust Fund (the "Health Plan") have amended the Health Plan to waive cost-sharing for Coronavirus (COVID-19) testing. In addition, the Health Plan will waive cost-sharing for items or services related to the administration of such testing or the evaluation of the need for such testing when furnished during an office visit (including a telehealth visit), urgent-care center visit, or emergency room visit.

This means that no copayment applies for In-Network and Out-of-Network providers for these services, and no deductible applies for Out-of-Network providers for these services, either. However, if an Out-of-Network provider charges more than the Plan's Maximum Allowable charge, you will be responsible for any amounts beyond the Maximum Allowable charge. This is known as "balance billing."

This change is effective for dates of service from March 18, 2020 until either the national emergency declared by the President or the public health emergency declared by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services is lifted.

Copayments (and, for Out-of-Network providers, deductibles) still apply for office, urgent care center, and emergency room visits and for diagnostic tests for any other reason. For example, patients seeking care for conditions unrelated to COVID-19 would be subject to any applicable copayment or deductible.
